2020 Alta Langa Limited Edition, Fontanafredda

Tucked among the rolling hills of northern Italy, the iconic Fontanafredda estate has been producing wines for generations. During a recent visit, our team had the pleasure of exploring this historic vineyard – and this stood out as a clear favourite.

Part of the estate’s prestigious Selezioni range, the Alta Langa Limited Edition represents the heart and soul of Fontanafredda’s winemaking. Under the careful eye of winemaker Danilo Drocco, these wines blend heritage with subtle innovation, always staying true to their Piedmont roots.

Made from pinot noir and chardonnay, using the traditional “Talento” method (Italy’s name for the classic bottle-fermented technique), this vintage is a brilliant expression of Italian sparkling wine at its most elegant. Think Champagne rather than prosecco.

A beautiful straw yellow colour, with an inviting bouquet of toasted nuts and rich, lifted aromatics. On the palate, it’s crisp, dry, and balanced, with a clean finish that leaves a lasting impression.

Indulge, unwind, and let this wine transport you to the breathtaking Alta Langa hills — a place where time slows down, and every glass tells a story.

Napoleon once famously said, ‘In victory you deserve Champagne, in defeat you need it.’ So, however your day’s been, here are our top picks from Champagne Taittinger. It’s one of the few remaining Champagne houses still owned and managed by the family whose name is on the label. They oversee about 288 hectares of premium quality vineyards across the Champagne region, headquartered in Reims.

3	Domaine Evremond Classic Cuvée NV - UK 12%	£12.50	£69.00	
A unique partnership between Champagne Taittinger and their British friends, Hatch Mansfield. Domaine Evremond marks the first Champagne house to invest in the UK with the ambition of producing a top-quality sparkling wine. The vines have been developing in their new Kent home since the project was launched in 2015, benefitting from chalky soil and a mild climate. Oh, and it was good enough to be served at a banquet attended by King Charles and the French President.

Hattingley Valley

In the picturesque countryside of Hampshire, UK, you'll find Hattingley Valley. Owned by the Robinson family, this gem of English wines has swiftly risen to prominence since its founding in 2008.

The vineyard boasts hectares of prime chalky soils, reminiscent of the Champagne region in France, providing an ideal environment for producing exceptional sparkling wines. The cooler English climate ensures a slow ripening process, which is crucial for maintaining the grapes' natural acidity and vibrant character.

At the heart of Hattingley Valley's success is a commitment to sustainability and meticulous craftsmanship. The estate employs cutting-edge techniques and traditional methods, with the subtle use of oak barrels.

The silver-washed fritillary butterfly featured on every bottle is commonly seen in Europe, but rare in Britain. Simon Robinson, Hattingley's founder, discovered it in the family's vineyards, indicating a healthy environment. The natural biodiversity has been further enhanced by Simon's planting of around seven miles of hedgerow under a countryside stewardship scheme.

Meanwhile, up in the far north of Italy, we found a rich, floral and very dry pinot grigio. Great as an apéritif on a warm summer's day or match with light dishes, like salads or fish.

Think Loire Valley, heading south to the sunshine and the muscadet vineyards appear. 'Sur lie' adds richness to this tangy, crisp and refreshing white. It's a perfect accompaniment to fish dishes but also great as an apéritif.

Its name translates to 'winegrowers from the secret lands.' Imagine the sun-washed landscapes of the Mâconnais region, where this balanced chardonnay reveals white flower and peach notes, with a mist of citrus. Perfectly paired with chicken, goat's cheese or lighter dishes.				
13	2024 Free-Run Steen Chenin Blanc, MAN Family Wines – South Africa 13.5%			£33.00
South African chenin blanc is superb and this is a great example. A truly versatile wine to go with all manner of food, or equally great as an apéritif.

If you've chosen a dish with a bit of spice, this will be a perfect match. The off-dry, slight sweetness from the fruity riesling grapes helps to soften any spice in food.

Blending garnacha blanca and chardonnay, this wine sits on its lees to develop texture. The result is a dry, crisp, refreshing white, which is balanced and appealing.

2024 Gavi di Gavi, Ascheri

In the breathtaking hills of the Barolo region is the Ascheri estate, renowned for its Piedmontese heritage, family values and a deep respect for the land. Our team were warmly welcomed and left genuinely inspired when they visited - not only by the stunning landscape and elegant wines, but by the people behind them.

At the heart of it all is Matteo Ascheri, a winemaker as engaging as he is talented. His philosophy is refreshingly simple, yet deeply meaningful: let the grape, vineyard, and climate speak for themselves.

The estate's vineyards are farmed sustainably, following the principles of the Green Experience - a regional initiative that champions biodiversity, minimal intervention, and environmental care. It's a thoughtful approach not just for today's wine lovers, but for generations to come.

Matteo's dedication goes well beyond his own vineyard. As President of the Consorzio di Tutela Barolo Barbaresco Alba Langhe e Dogliani, he represents over 500 growers and 10,000 hectares

of vineyards - helping to preserve the traditions, reputation, and future of the Langhe and Roero regions, some of the most celebrated in Italian winemaking.

The 2024 Gavi di Gavi is a shining example - fresh, fragrant and graceful, with notes of wildflowers, citrus zest, and subtle herbal undertones, evoking a stroll through a northern Italian meadow.

Elegant, authentic and incredibly drinkable - it's a wine to enjoy now, with friends, and imagine being in one of Italy's most beautiful vineyards.

20	2024 Era Organic Grillo, Cantine Volpi – Italy 12.5%			£30.00
At the other end of Italy in Sicily, this dry, crisp white will impress. Certified organic, the vineyard adopts a form of 'clean' agriculture without chemical substances. Perfect with salads, shellfish, pasta and pizza.				
21	2024 Vermentino, Cala Silente, Santadi – Italy 13.5%			£41.00
Here's a bottle of Mediterranean sunshine from the vineyards of Sardinia. With flavours of apple, peach and citrus, this offers intense fruity flavours to go with rich foods and cheese.				
22	2023 Pinot Blanc Organic, Trimbach – France 13%			£45.00
The House of Trimbach in Alsace goes back centuries and is now run by the 12th generation of the family. Crisp and fruity, this pale yellow wine's a winner with spicy food, fish, shellfish, cheese and cured meats.				
23	2024 Fonte Vinho Verde, Aveleda – Portugal 9.5%			£29.00
Versatile for any occasion, this popular easy-drinking white is fresh, round and fruity, with a slight hint of spritz. Combining ancient traditions with modern wine making they have produced this fresh and vibrant blend of chardonnay and pinot bianco. Enjoy their Pomino Bianco that treats you to 'spring in every sip.'

2024 Langhe Nebbiolo Organic DOC, La Spinetta

La Spinetta was one of the vineyards we were most excited to visit—and it did not disappoint. Led by the charismatic Giorgio Rivetti, this family-run estate is a beacon of innovation and tradition in the Langhe hills. Ranked the second-highest acclaimed winery in Italy by Gambero Rosso, La Spinetta has built its reputation on a deep respect for the land, meticulous organic practices, and a relentless drive for quality.

It was the 2023 Langhe Nebbiolo Organic DOC that stood out for us—and it’s the wine we’ve chosen to feature. Grown in organically-farmed vineyards in the Langhe, where the warmth of the Mediterranean climate meets the foothills of the Alps. This Nebbiolo offers a fresh and expressive introduction to one of Italy’s most noble grape varieties, traditionally used to produce the king of wines: Barolo.

With its vibrant cherry-red hue, the wine opens with inviting aromas of ripe plum, balancing flavours of currants and black cherry. There’s real elegance, a

purity of fruit and sense of place that makes it both approachable and complex - a perfect reflection of the Rivetti Family’s winemaking philosophy.

Tasting this wine in La Spinetta’s stunning cellar in Barolo, surrounded by barrels and history, was an unforgettable moment. The energy, dedication, and personality behind this bottle were unmistakable, and we knew it had to be on our list. The 2023 Langhe Nebbiolo is a wine that tells the story of La Spinetta - its past, passion and future - in every sip.

The rich flavours of black cherry, blackberry, and tobacco are complemented by hints of vanilla and dark chocolate, leading to a long, satisfying finish. An excellent companion for grilled meats, pasta dishes and aged cheeses.

Fancy a glass of red, but having the chicken? This Beaujolais works. It might be a bright, brick red colour in the glass, but the gamay grape is very light and pairs well with white meats, richer fish or soft white cheese. Best served slightly chilled.				
39	2021 Bordeaux Supérieur, Château de Camarsac Vieilles Vignes – France 13%			£40.00
The Château de Camarsac is a perfect example of why it's worth seeking out the families and properties that make up the jewels of the Bordeaux Supérieur appellation. This is a 65:35 merlot:cabernet sauvignon mix from vines over 30 years old. Mellow with this big red, which delivers an explosion of red and black fruit.

46	2021 Puente de Salceda Crianza, Viña Salceda - Spain 14.5%	£33.00
This Crianza hails from the prestigious Rioja region, known for producing some of Spain’s finest wines. Viña Salceda was founded in Eltziego in 1969 in a picturesque town in the Rioja Alavesa. Since 1998, it has belonged to the Chivite family, who are committed to the production of wines of the highest quality and have gained a reputation as one of Rioja’s icon wineries. Their vineyards enjoy a special microclimate thanks to the Cantabria Mountains to the north and the Demanda Mountain Range to the south.

From the vineyards just outside Stellenbosch, Meinert Wines are one to watch. This cabernet sauvignon feels soft but mouth-filling, making it the perfect partner with vegetarian dishes and of course, rich, meaty dishes.			
48	2021 Carménère Reserva, Viña Falernia – Chile 14%		£36.00
Brilliant and inky-deep violet in colour, this carménère comes to you from the northerly vineyards of Chile in the Elqui Valley. It pairs well with grilled meat, pork, pasta and spicy foods..			
49	2022 Chinon Tradition, Pierre Sourdais – France 12.5%		£40.00
The historic town of Chinon sits on the River Vienne, close to the Loire. This juicy red is 100% cabernet franc and a perfect match to grilled meats, game or mature cheese.

This is a top-tier malbec from Patagonia, one of the most southerly regions in the world. Thanks to the cooler climate, the grapes can ripen slowly, adding complexity and elegance. Strong winds from the Antarctic provide added benefits, reducing the risk of disease. Humberto Canale is an authentic family-owned winery, providing work and housing for local residents.

From the region of Lazio, which covers the area around Rome, this beautiful wine hails from the town of Velletri. We dispatched our executive chef, Anuj, to find out more and he returned full of excitement and interesting facts. Its primary grape is merlot to which cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc are added. The result gives sleek tannins with a dark-fruited finish. Anuj’s advice: pitch with flavourful dishes such as game and red meat.			
52	2023 Briccotondo Barbera Piemonte DOC, Fontanafredda - Italy 13.5%		£36.00

This smooth, expressive Barbera comes from the beautiful hills of Piedmont, a celebrated wine region, known for its rich history, rolling vineyards, and characterful reds. Produced by the iconic Fontanafredda estate, it offers layers of ripe cherry, plum, and a gentle hint of spice, all wrapped in soft tannins and a velvety finish.It’s a personal favourite from our visit and we’re delighted to be able to share it with you.
